



## APPOINTMENT LETTER

This letter confirms that **Avgoustinos Tsaousis** from Cyprus has been appointed as **Scientix Ambassador** from 24 May 2023 until 31 December 2024.

Scientix is the largest community for science education in Europe. It started in 2010 as an initiative funded by the European Commission which promotes and supports a Europe-wide collaboration among STEM (science, technology, engineering, and maths) teachers, education researchers, policymakers, and other STEM education professionals. From the beginning, Scientix has been coordinated by European Schoolnet (EUN), a Brussels-based non-profit organisation of 34 Ministries of Education, which has been driving innovation in teaching and learning, and fostering pan-European collaboration of schools and teachers since its inception.

Scientix Ambassadors support the dissemination of Scientix and the exchange of practices and knowledge between all STEM education stakeholders. Scientix Ambassadors help share Scientix activities at national level and play an active role in supporting innovation in STEM education in their countries. They present Scientix in schools and national teachers associations, on conferences and workshops, and can advise teachers how to get involved in European collaboration in STEM. They also assist in developing and testing various tools and services of Scientix and ensure the pedagogical quality of the Scientix repository. Scientix Ambassadors do not represent Scientix/EUN.
